Discipline Policy

Guidance procedures - The Bible teaches that God disciplines us out of love. At Zion, an attitude of unconditional love is maintained even if a child needs discipline. The school policy is based on positive guidance techniques. They include:

- Staff who model caring Christian behaviors.
- Simple, understandable rules that set limits for behavior necessary to the well-being of all children.
- A daily routine that is consistent and provides many opportunities for children to make choices.
- "Using words" to express feelings and to problem solve.
- Redirecting or, at times, ignoring inappropriate behavior.
- Removing a child from the group, if a child is disruptive. A teacher will stay near the child and after 2 to 4 minutes (one minute for each year of the child's life) the teacher will discuss the situation with the child.

Parents will be notified when a child repeatedly violates school standards or threatens the safety of others. The goal of all discipline procedures is to help the child develop positive self-esteem and self-control. Through the example of God's love and forgiveness, children learn to forgive each other and themselves, and make choices based on Christian values.

Disenrollment - When a family chooses to disenroll, we request a two week notice to prepare the child and his classmates for the transition. All tuition must be paid in full. Copies of the child's records will be provided upon request.

Zion Lutheran reserves the right to disenroll any child if:

- Parental responsibilities to the preschool are not met.
- If the staff feels the needs of the child cannot be met with the classroom.
- If the safety of the staff or of the children is in jeopardy.

Before disenrollment takes place, teachers and administration of the preschool, in cooperation with the parents, will make every effort to meet the needs of the family. Observations or disciplinary options may be discussed to resolve problems. Documentation and conferences as well as referrals to other services that could meet the needs of the child will be provided. Dismissal will always be done on an individual basis. On days of very disturbing behavior, the parent may be called to take the child home for the day. In the case of divorce, separation, or child custody, our center follows court orders. We will not try to settle domestic disputes.

Documentation - Teachers must keep written records of children who require more than normal guidance. Descriptions of behavior, discipline and methods implemented should be added to the file and parents must be made aware of the situation. Discussion with parents should be documented and added to the child's file also.
