Jesus Time: - Jesus Calms the Storm (Mark 4:35-41)

- ◆ This week we concluded our learning of the story of Jesus calming the storm. From this story, we learned that we do not need to be afraid because Jesus is always with us! Ask your child to share the story with you.

Pumpkins:

- ◆ After reading *A Day at the Pumpkin Patch* and learning how pumpkins grow, the children were able to explore the outside and insides of our classroom pumpkin. We then placed it outside to see if any animals would eat it. Ask your child to tell you what we saw!
- ◆ We used our classroom pumpkin for math estimation games to find out its weight and how many seeds it had. We also used it for a science experiment to see if it would sink or float in water.
- ◆ We continued our week by reading *The Biggest Pumpkin Ever*. We practiced with numbers when we played a seed counting game.
- ◆ We followed a recipe to make oven roasted pumpkin seeds and ate them during snack. We then graphed whether or not each child liked eating them.
- ◆ We ended our learning of pumpkins by using paint to decorate our very own small pumpkin gourd.

Upcoming Week

We will start next week with leaves as we continue to learn about the season of fall and the changes that we are experiencing. During Jesus Time we will introduce the story of the man who said thank you. From this story, the children will learn about thanking God for all he has blessed us with in our lives!!
