The children have had a very exciting week learning about **colors**. On Monday we read a book titled *Rabbit's Book of Colors*. The children learned about color mixing. We combined art and science together. The children were given a ziplock bag and inside I put shaving cream and two different colors of food coloring. (The children choose which 2 colors they wanted.)
